### Village Hall Fundraising





We would be delighted to receive suggestions of what you would like to see planted as part of our first crop, perhaps a herb such as parsley, rosemary, thyme, mint....or salad leaves, tomatoes, leeks or other fresh veg..? Hopefully, dates for our first planting session will be communicated within the next couple of weeks. We look forward to continuing our support for this little gem of a Tea Room, which opens for the 2022 season on Friday, O1st April.

### Lockton Parish Council chosen to pilot "Night Tune" street lighting as part of the successful North York Moors Dark Skies Initiative
