Our main news is that Lockton Parish Council has a new website!!



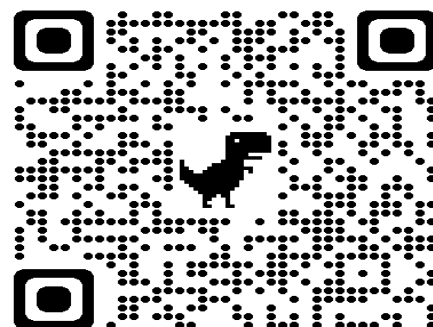
