Projects within the village

You may have noticed Mike (Bennett) completing some of the maintenance jobs around the village, which helps to keep the place looking tidy. So far, the paths leading up to the cemetery have been cleared, the bus stop roof has had all the ivy removed, the front walls of the Church and parts of the graveyard have also had a tidy. The bench on the corner leading to Levisham is being removed as it is damaged, and that area around the bins has also been cut back. Future projects include the reduction of the hedges in the cemetery, further kerb side and pavements cleared, more targeted weed spraying, and remaining benches oiled for the winter. We welcome any further suggestions of maintenance jobs to keep the village looking clean and tidy, so please feel free to email through your requests. Over the next month, we will be focusing our efforts on applying for a further grant for the Parish, ideas so far include using the intended money to renovate the village general noticeboards, as well as complete some repairs to the village playground.
